

- to support Central Baptist in sending members to minister cross-culturally






# ATORKOR STUDENT ACCOMMODATION SUMMER 2019

Prepare and paint four dormitories, each for four students plus windows and doors
Prepare and paint five toilet blocks
Prepare and paint five bathrooms
Prepare and paint outside of building

#### TOOLS AND MATERIALS

- White paint for ceilings
- Magnolia paint for walls
- Undercoat coat for doors and windows
- Top coat for doors and windows
- 8 emulsion brushes/trays and rollers, 8 undercoat paint brushes and 8 gloss paint brushes. I 00 sheets of sandpaper and blocks
- Thinners

#### TIME AWAY AND COST

- Estimated time away is 2 weeks.
- Cost of accommodation nil
- Cost of air flight £1200
- Cost of food for two weeks £100 per person
- Cost of container and shipping of equipment £1500 approx £200 per person
- Cost of paint and equipment £100 per person
- Unknowns £300 per person
- Total cost per person to be raised £2000

#### **FUND RAISING**

- Sponsored walk, run, cycle, carer, baby sit will raise £500 easily, £1000 with difficulty but these are best as you have a 'good cause'
- For young people Parents and Grandparents might raise £1000.
- Boot Sales might raise £300 but these are not always profitable
